How to Pray FOR THOSE YOU LOVE

Matthew 18:19 explains a great prayer promise. The unhindered, agreement (of mothers and fathers, husbands and wives, grandparents, and all who disciple) in prayer is one of the greatest powers possible! Unleash those Word-filled prayers by following the four prayer-focusing examples on this card.

1. Pray they experience reality in their spiritual lives:

By Saving Faith —

"Open their eyes... turn them from darkness to light... from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins..." ACTS 26:18

By Loving God's Word —

"I... have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food" JOB 23:12

By Living Victoriously —

"You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free..." JOHN 8:32, 36

By Thinking of Heaven —

"... Seek those things which are above. ... Set your mind on things above" COLOSSIANS 3:1-2

By Hating Sin —

"I will declare my iniquity; I will be in anguish over my sin" PSALM 38:18

By Staying Tender toward God —

"A broken and contrite heart—These, O God, You will not despise" PSALM 51:17

2. Pray for integrity in their personal lives:

By Maintaining a Clear Conscience —

"... Love from a pure heart, [from] a good conscience, and [from] sincere faith" 1 TIMOTHY 1:5

By Learning to Stand Alone —

"But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself" DANIEL 1:8

By Seeking to Stay Pure in Mind and Body —

"... abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul" 1 PETER 2:11

By Evidencing a Servant's Heart —

"Whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all" MARK 10:44-45

By Not Being Bitter in Trials —

"Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you" EPHESIANS 4:30-32

3. Pray they reflect Christ's love in their relationships:

By Cultivating Love for Others —

By Trusting God When Trouble Comes —
